

Free Lending Library for Parents & Caregivers

The Swindells Resource Center is a non-profit, local organization that supports families who have children with disabilities or special needs. They have a **free lending library** with thousands of books about parenting, specific disabilities or diagnoses, etc.

You can search their catalog and they will mail to you – free of charge – the book you would like to borrow. Swindells will also send you pre-paid return envelope to return the book when you are done with it. You can check out books for 3 weeks and can renew them if needed.

How to use the Swindells Lending Library:

- 1. Go to Swindells Resource Center homepage: www.ProvidenceOregon.org/Swindells
- 2. Click on the link that says "online library". This will take you to the library catalog.
- 3. Search for books. When you find a book, write down the title and author.
- 4. Call Swindells Resource Center at (503) 215-2429 to request the book. They will send you the book in the mail with a pre-paid return envelope. It costs you nothing!
